The South West Herts Narrowboat Project would like to invite you aboard the project's two narrowboats, on Sunday 1st October 2017 to find out how to get your young people away for a unique weekend on the canal.

South West Herts Narrowboat Project exists to provide narrow boating experiences to community and youth groups. We run two boats: Pickle's Folly and Dick's Folly, which are fully equipped and can accommodate up to 12 people.

Narrow boating offers young people a wide range of challenges: navigation and route planning for the journey, steering a boat through the open countryside, working the locks and experiencing the tunnels, discovering a world rich in resources, learning to live together away from the home environment, shopping, cooking, encouraging teamwork and developing self-esteem and respect for others.

This relaxed open day will let you know more about what the project has to offer, give you a chance to meet the team and find out how you could get your youth members and leaders afloat on the project's boats. You will also have the opportunity to experience a trip aboard the boats and find out what is involved in piloting a 70' narrow boat along the canal.

We will be meeting for 9.30am at the project's base and moorings at Old Mill Road, Hunton Bridge, Kings Langley, Herts WD4 8QT, for refreshments and a look around the project, before we head off along the canal for the rest of the day. We will provide you with a light lunch and then return back to the project's base for 4.00pm.
